### NURSING/PREGNANT?

If the person is pregnant or breastfeeding we don't recommend the treatment



### SCARS

If the scar is flat or indented the treatment can be done. Hypertrophic scar are okay to work with. The microblading treatment can not be done if the client has any keloid scar on their body.



### MOLE, SKIN TAG, PIMPLE

We can still do the treatment but we must avoid going over a mole, skin tag or a pimple.



### CANCER

The immune system is compromised during cancer treatments and we can only perform microblading with a medical clearance from their physician.



### BOTOX

It is best to wait a month before or after the botox to proceed with the microblading treatment.



### ACUTANE

The client must wait a minimum of 6 months before they can receive any type of treatment. medical clearance required



### TOPICAL CREAMS

Products that could cause bleeding:

- RetinA / Retinols
- Anti-aging creams
- Glycolic, salicylic or lactic acid products
- Mild acne creams
- Brow or lash growth serums

Color could disappear faster or may migrate giving more of a shaded look. Keep in mind, it may also hurt more while microblading.



### DIABETES

Diabetic clients are more prone to infections and they heal slower. It is necessary that sugar levels are regulated below 200 to proceed with the treatment.



### EPILEPSY

The trauma and the stress of the microblading treatment can contribute to a seizure. The treatment can not be done.
